Dr. C. Mark Smith is the Director of the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) Office of Research and Standards (ORS) and manages the science program at the Wall Experiment Station (WES), the state environmental laboratory. In these capacities he directs MassDEP's toxicology, risk assessment, emerging contaminants and environmental research programs, including efforts to assess risks and establish state policies for a range of pollutants ranging from PFAS to pathogens. He has published in the areas of environmental policy, molecular toxicology and risk assessment.
