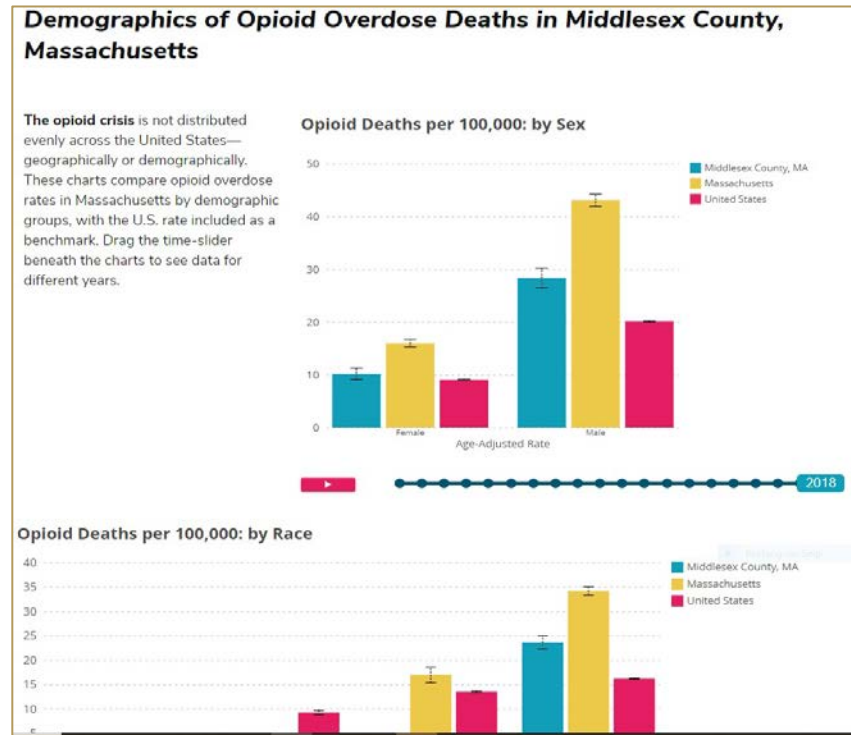
### Our Mission



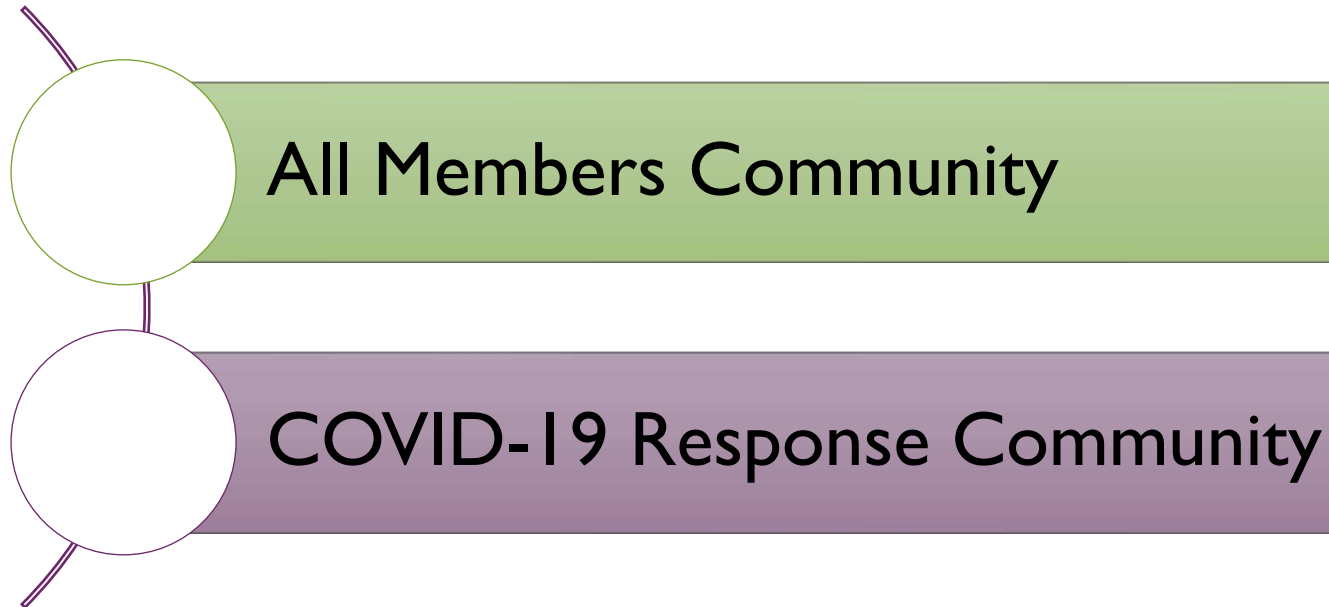
